ENGLISH

In English, we delved into an imaginary world of fiction. “A bad case of stripes”, was a story we really enjoyed reading and acting out. We sorted through simple present and past tenses, and started planning how to write fantasy stories. Finally, we have been getting ready for starting our weekly spelling lists in April.

SCIENCE

The skeleton has been the main topic in Science this point. We have made models and learned about the functions of the skeleton and joints. We investigated the lengths of different bones, making comparisons and recording the results on basic charts.
