MARCH HIGHLIGHTS

ENGLISH-

We were reading some classic fictions with different types of narrative techniques. We worked together to infer the characters, role of the author and compared with stories in which the narrator is the character. We practiced short story writing using a first person narrative technique. We also revised prefixes and suffixes in order to support spelling strategies.

MATH

Kids were learning place value up to millions, rounding of numbers in thousands, ten thousands, etc. We spent time learning about prime numbers and their multiples and factors. Problem solving was used to identify multiples and factors.

SCIENCE

We have been learning about body organs and their functions, Specifically, we read about digestive system and respiratory systems. We drew sketches of the body and location of the organs. Students watched videos related to the digestive system and respiratory system which helped them to connect to what they learn.
