APRIL HIGHLIGHTS

ENGLISH

The class has completed the first five phases of Jolly Phonics and associated letter formation, getting quicker and neater everyday. We started individualized spelling tests in the back of our books. We learnt how to use a dictionary properly and the concept of alphabetical order. We commenced sentence formation and differences in nouns. We then started on the concept of verbs/actions and how to identify them in a sentence. We continued also with Friday morning reading a story in class to incorporate listening practice.

SCIENCE

We learnt that plants grow best when they have the right conditions. If the temperature is too cold then the plant will grow slowly. If the temperature is too hot the plant will grow fast and then die. If the temperature is warm then the plant will grow well and thrive. We then revised everything we had learnt. We started on the next topic Healthy Bodies.



MATHS

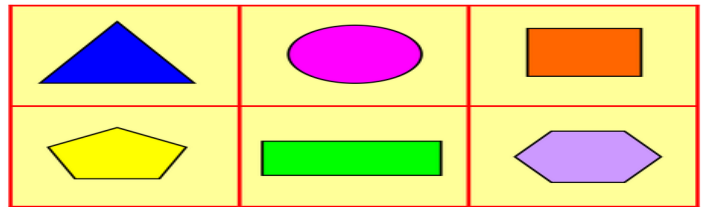
We continued by learning the 3 Times Table, doubling and halving numbers and adding numbers to themselves. We also practiced adding numbers up to 10 when it was clear they had forgotten. We then revised everything we had learnt using the Maths Extension Book.

SOCIAL STUDIES

We have been learning all about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We have looked at what happened when Stone Age people stopped being nomadic hunter-gathers and settled down in one place. They began to build villages and grow crops and build places like Stonehenge.
